

Building Networks of Support

Graduation Alliance has been working with school districts to provide the flexibility, academic interventions, and social-emotional support students need to get back to school and prepare for college or careers. Here are layers of staff support we build around each student.

Academic Coaches

Academic coaches work one-on-one with students to help them map out their academic journey and stay on track for graduation. They make proactive contact with students several times each week.



24-7 Tutors

At any time of the day or night, students can reach professional tutors who are ready and able to help them overcome challenging problems or concepts.



Licensed Teachers

Teachers who are specifically trained to work with at-risk students grade coursework, provide feedback, and are available during office hours to consult about courses and curriculum.



Local Advocates

A member of the community, usually trained in social work, meets weekly with each student to proctor tests, address social-emotional needs, and provide a connection to necessary resources.
